VISIT TO ROMANIA



In April, David Mercer (R) and Howard Richards (L) joined Andy for a visit to see the work of ACV in Romania.

David and Howard are part of Waterloo Road Chapel, a long-standing DT partner church. This was their first visit to Romania and with Andy, they met ACV volunteers as well as different groups of people that we work with.

David: It was a wonderful experience to meet the beautiful people of Romania. Visiting the night shelter had a strong impact on me - to see how people so less fortunate than most, were so welcoming. The trip impacted me in many ways and will live in my memory for the foreseeable future.

Howard: Romania has been an absolute eye opener of feeling the Holy Spirit's presence, showing the love of Jesus through his work. Since having time away in Romania doing God's work, I feel it has given me a true sense of spending quality time with God and let God show me his love (for us and for others). When it's time to receive his love, we often feel unworthy of it. I need to put doing God's work at the centre of my life, rather than corporate stuff. It's about what really matters, who should we be showing up for day in. day out - and that is Jesus.

1-8 JUNE

- 8th We give thanks for another good DTAH Course Foundations of the Christian Faith, in May. Despite lower numbers, it has been useful to remind ourselves of some of the basic beliefs we hold to and why!

FOCUS ON

PARISH OF KARAMA



The sub-parish of Karama is in the diocese of Gasabo and is located around 6km from Kigali. It is on top of a hill (as are most places in Rwanda!) and has a population of around 15,000. Employment is primarily micro businesses with some local art/craft businesses as well. There are local schools and a health centre. It is in the process of becoming an independent parish.

There is a church building which the congregation plan to renovate soon. The congregation numbers 209 (82 adults,

69 young people and 58 children) and there are activities for all ages. They have a focus on outreach, marriage counselling and helping young people to create income-generating projects. There are 5 choirs and 7 home groups, all of which help with strengthening discipleship.

The parish is overseen by Pastor Clement and his wife Marie Immacuee. They have two young children. Clement made a commitment to Jesus when he was 21 years old. As well as being a pastor, Clement is also head teacher in the local church school. He was ordained in 2023.

Please pray for the evangelism of the parish as they engage with people in different programmes. Pray too for the practical needs, such as a church house for the pastor and space for a growing congregation.

Originally available only in text format, audio versions were added in 2020.

Whilst daily users are not high compared to other available options, we have built up a dedicated audience in both the UK and overseas including India, USA, Canada, Australia and others in between. As well as those subscribers to the daily email service, we have an average of 196 people reading / listening via the DT website each month from across the world.

It's always good to get response and we are encouraged to know that this ministry is appreciated - and shared! It's so good to know that what is written/edited a month or more before going live can be used by the Holy Spirit to speak into people's situations as if written specifically for them at that time.
